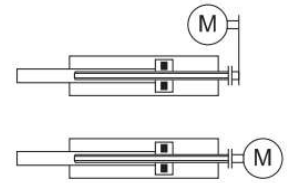


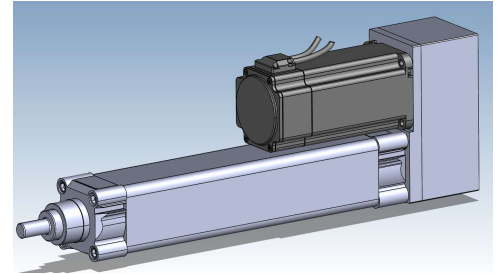
The IMT actuators are developed for application requiring linear movements and positioning to a high degree of accuracy, repeatability and speed variations in synchronised system.

They are made with a ball screw, which is rotated by an electric motor, and a ball nut driving the external piston for the ISO 15552 cylinder.

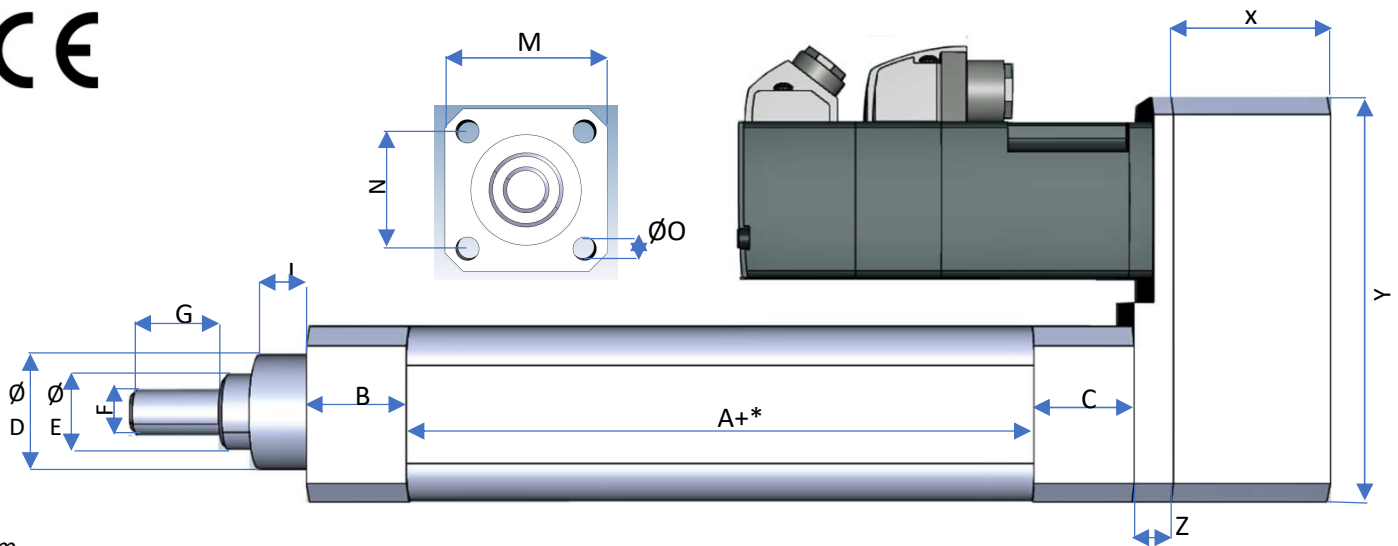
